IMAAC reports more than 8% growth in 2023...

erosol production in Mexico saw an 8.17% gain in 2023 over the previous year, according to data from Instituto Mexicano Del Aerosol, A.C. (Mexican Aerosol Institute or IMAAC). A trend of growth in the country over the past several years continued, with 785.61 million units produced in 2023, compared to 726.3 million units in 2022.

The Personal Care category held the largest share of the 2023 fillings at almost 65%, increasing 7.43% from the previous year to 507.18 million units. The Food category, which was introduced in 2021, made

an impressive leap of 333.49% with 39.62 million units filled.

All other categories saw a slight decline. Household Care products fell 3.17%, with 46.98 million units filled in 2022 versus 48.47 million units the year before. Industrial/Automotive products dropped 6.76% to 30.31 million units filled, while Insecticides had a small decrease (0.15%) in 2023 to 104.65 million units. Paints declined 5.1% to 45.26 million units filled. Other products dropped 2.07% with 11.59 million units filled (11.83 million units were filled in 2022). SPRAY
